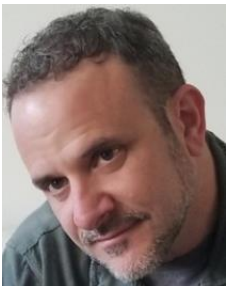

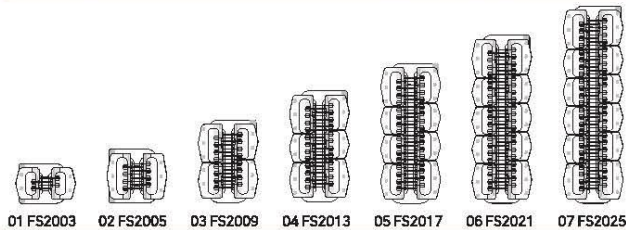
- There is a disadvantage that the pulled skin becomes uncomfortable as it is sutured by pulling only one skin based on the incision line.
- Due to the high height of the molded object, there is a disadvantage that cotton or gauze gets caught on the strap when dressing.
- If the molded object is high and used for a patient with spine surgery, the patient's pain is severe because the molded object is pressed against the surgery area.
